Submissions embodying conceptual and empirical research such as articles, papers, interviews, notes, squibs are encouraged. Annotated bibliography and review of recently-published books on Translation Studies, Interpretation Studies and Adaptation Studies are also welcome. Translation Today is a member of Crossref. Contents published in this journal carry a unique DOI and are licensed under Creative Commons. The journal is indexed in MLA International Bibliography, MIAR, Directory of Research Jounral Index (DRJI), Citefactor, ABCD, Translation Studies Bibliography (TSB) of John Benjamin, International Scientific Indexing (ISI), ERIH PLUS and COSMOS.

Articles submitted for consideration of the Board will have to be in English. Translation Today will seriously consider the possibility of publishing material in Indian languages, or a multilingual edition of the journal in future. Articles should be preferably between 4000 and 5000 words in length. Unpublished contributions will be preferred. While submitting pieces already published elsewhere, the author must mention the fact as well as get permission to reproduce the same. The submission should be by e-mail. Please use .doc or .txt format. Graphics could be in JPEG or PNG format. All articles should carry a 100-word abstract and a short bio-note of the contributor.

Style and Conventions

The journal prefers the American Psychological Association (APA) style. Diagrams and figures should be suitable for photographic/scanner reproduction. Drawings should be in black font. Lettering should be of draughtsman standard and large enough to remain legible where the figure requires reduction in size. Tables should be typed on separate sheets.

Author's Benefit

All the contributors from India would receive a complimentary copy (print) of the journal and overseas contributors would receive an e-copy of the journal.

Reviewing System

The Translation Today follows double-blind peer-review policy. At first, the received paper is reviewed by the editors. If the editors find the paper suitable for the journal qualitatively, then the paper is sent to the experts who review the paper based on the guidelines of the Translation Today. The decision of accepting a paper for publication depends on the review report. Please see the Review Response Sheet in the NTM website.

Publication Fee

Translation Today does not charge any submission, processing or publication fees at any stage of publication.
