अनुवादक शिक्षा कार्यक्रम Translators' Education Programme

Skill development of translators is one of the focus areas of National Translation Mission. The Mission offers training to translators in the form of Intensive Programme and Orientation Programme. It also offers academic support to professional translators. Efforts are on to offer Certificate and Diploma programms in Translation and Certification of Translators.

Details about 2-Week Intensive Training Programme

Who should attend? This programme is for those who translate as a hobby or wish to build a career as a translator. It is also for professional translators and Translation Studies students who want to enhance their knowledge and improve their skills. The participants usually include (a) Early-career employees and students of various universities/institutions, (b) Language officers working in different government and semi-government set-ups, (c) Persons involved in dictionary/glossary preparation activities.

When? The schedule for the current batch of the training programme (year 2025-26) is as follows:

Fee: The fee for this programme is NIL. Selected applicants need to deposit a sum of Rs. 500/- that is adjustable with one-year subscription of the *Translation Today Journal*.

Travel Assistance: The participants need to arrange their travel on their own. NTM is not able to provide any travel assistance.

Accommodation: The training programme provides free boarding and lodging facility (on shared basis) at the Institute for the programme dates. Those who arrive before the scheduled or checkout late, need to inform in advance and pay the charges as per the norms of the Institute. The payment should be done before vacating the premises and a copy of the receipt is to be shared with NTM administration for reference. In case of non-availability of accommodation on campus, NTM collaborates with neighbouring institutions for the same. Participants desirous of making their own arrangements for stay/food are free to do so. Relatives/Friends/Accompanying persons are not allowed, as the food and accommodation facilities are limited.

Food: Food and refreshments are arranged for all participants on campus

How to apply? Interested persons may log on to www.ntm.org.in and fill in the registration form. At the time of attending the programme, it is a mandatory to submit one set of application and copies of highest qualification and age-proof.

Who are the trainers? NTM has a pool of trainers who are established experts in the field of translation, Translation Studies and translation- relevant fields. Some trainers work as in-house resource persons at NTM, CIIL while others are engaged from different Institutions from across the country.

Distinction: This programme is unique as it blends theoretical discussions and practical activities. A wide range of topics / themes are addressed and the participants are exposed to the latest trends and technologies. Participants are involved is proofing, post editing and validation of AI-based and Machine-translated texts.
